


The European Academy on Youth Work took place in Slovenia from the 21<sup>st</sup> - 24<sup>th</sup> of may. Over 140 participants were invited to discuss current trends, innovation and policy making in youth work. Fortunately our small NGO, *The Pigeon Plan,* was chosen to be one of 36 contributors from diverse countries and backgrounds (also outside Europe). During the week the participants had the chance to select 6 workshops, which presented and shared a range of tools, methods and practices from various fields.
